AT-RISK YOUTH



SALVATION

"The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship. And by him we cry, "Abba, Father." Romans 8:15, NIV

- Pray that God will guide at-risk youth to salvation despite their circumstances.

OUR COMMUNITIES

- Pray for God to protect and bless the families in our community who have been called out of comfort and into engagement on behalf of hurting children.

TRANSFORMATION
